## **BACKGROUND**

Ratanda care works treats about 5Ml/day of sewer accommodating the Ratanda township, due to the nature of our business it is important to ensure safe drinking water for the personnel working in the plant, Ratanda Works does not have a potable water supply point from the municipality and therefore relies on borehole water for domestic purposes including drinking, borehole water is extracted from the ground with chemicals, which can cause water to harden, scale, turbidity as well as odour and odd taste, therefore ERWAT is therefore seeking qualified bidders to respond to the invitation of the bid above.

#### **SCOPE OF WORKS:**

## Supply, delivery and installation of Water purification system, between pump and Buffer Tank,

- Water must be purified before entering the Buffer Tank to ensure that water consumed in the plant must be safe to drink
- Purification system must remove turbidity and improve the taste of the water
- Purification system must be capable of removing Fluoride, Chloride, Barium, Copper, Nitrates,
   Iron and Sodium
- Bidder must provide guarantee of removal of all the chemicals mentioned above especially nitrates
- The membrane must be capable of removing sediments, asbestos, and any suspended organic material along with virtually all micro-organisms such as Bacteria , E-coli, cysts, virus and Pyrogen
- Purification must include components of Softening hard water
- The purification system must be capable of removing all pathogens that can possibly be on the water
- Final product to the Buffer water tank must comply with the SANS 241:2015 (Bidders to familiarise themselves with this regulations before Quotation to ensure installing the correct Equipment)
